

Climate of USA




Due to the large area of the country, the climate in the United States is very diverse. Conventionally, there are Eastern and Western climatic regions on the territory of the country.

In summer, the temperature in most areas ranges from +22°C to +28°C, while the difference between the northern and southern states is relatively small. Winter in most of the country is quite mild - the average January temperature ranges from -2°C in the north to +8°C in the south.

Occupying almost half of the mainland, the country has a huge range of natural and climatic conditions. On the territory of the United States, you can find both hot arid deserts and humid evergreen forests, both harsh mountainous landscapes and endless expanses of grassy plains or dense forests.



Climate of Kazakhstan



The climate in the republic is mostly sharply continental. In the south, the temperature in summer reaches + 49 degrees, and in the north in winter it can drop to -57 degrees. At the same time, the weather in the desert is often changeable and changeable, it is hot during the day, and at night the northern winds blow, which bring cold with them.

The nature of Kazakhstan is quite diverse and beautiful in its own way. A large part of the territory is occupied by semi-deserts and deserts, steppes make up 35% of the country's area, an insignificant part of the territory of Kazakhstan is occupied by forests.

Education system



The differences between secondary education in Kazakhstan and the USA are considerable, but children adapt successfully in American schools. The duration of schooling differs - 12 years in the US and 11 years in the Kazakhstan , the programmes, and the teaching methods. Unlike Kazakhstan , there is no unified educational standard in the USA. Each school has different time allocated to compulsory subjects and electives, teaching methods and curricula. The most common grading system in American schools is letter grading. It consists of a scale from A to F. The grading process is varied by the + and - grades, which allow further clarification of the depth of knowledge demonstrated by the child.



Economics of USA and Kazakhstan



The economic system of the United States is characterized by globalization. Even a person who does not have deep financial knowledge understands that the only universal currency that is actually recognized throughout the world is the US dollar.

Most countries in the world are also investing billions of dollars in the US economy. The US is central to the global economy.

Whereas in the Kazakh mentality, this is the norm. Americans don't care about their appearance, their clothes, or their hair. While it is very important for Kazakh women and Kazakhs to look their best. Americans and Kazakhs are similar in family values. Americans are tolerant of everything. While Kazakhs cannot tolerate anything that is outside of their understanding. LGBT, feminism, and many other things are uyat for the Kazakhs.




Structure of the state
