Goals of the seminar

1. Introduce the topic

Task 1. Draw STs' attention to the title of the lesson, look up any words they don't understand. Ask STs to discuss in pairs which of those words and phrases they expect in it and report their ideas.

Task 2. Ask students to read the first sentence, and then complete the second sentence so that it has a similar meaning to the first. Point out that they must use between two and five words including the word given. Remind students that they mustn't change the word given.

Task 3. Ask students to look at the Writing bank and match the topics with the groups of expressions. Elicit more expressions to add to each group.

Task 4. Play the track for students to listen to four people describing their jobs. Ask students to match each person to one of the jobs. Elicit the key words that helped students decide on their answer.
