INTRODUCTION

The exam in the discipline "Political Science" will be held in writing form. The exam is held in offline. The percentage of originality of the text is 65%. Plagiarism in any form - cheating, using synonymizers, replacing characters - is prohibited.

The exam format is offline.

Proctoring (English "proctor" - to control the course of the exam). The proctors, in exam in the classroom, make sure that the examinees pass the test honestly: they complete the assignments on their own and do not use additional materials.

Exam regulations.

The exam will be held in writing form. The exam will be held in an offline format. The exam will take place in the auditorium, where there will be a proctor. Proctor will monitor the exam.

Don't forget to check your exam schedule regularly. On exam day don't forget to take two blue ink pens, documents (student ID, passport/national ID). Write legibly, understandably, do not leave signs and do not strike out, do not cross out anything. Only academic style of writing, no requests in the text of the answer ("I did not prepare", "I need a scholarship", "put high points", etc.) - only your answer. Give your answer as completely as possible - no minimum words, but don't limit yourself to one or two sentences per question.

The exam lasts 90 minutes. You will be given 3 questions, which you will have to answer in writing form.

Satisfactory	50-69	The task was completed satisfactorily. Student answered correctly 50-69% of the questions.
Unsatisfactory	0-49	Student's knowledge on the topic is less than 50%. Accordingly, less than 50 correct answers.
