

PT 6. Individual-typological features of personality.

To complete the PT-6 assignment, split into teams of 4-5 people (no more) and prepare a presentation for the Week 6 Seminar class.

Each team will report the developed topic by the presentation to the rest of the group. Teamwork is worth 50% out of 15 points. The remaining 50% you can earn through your part of oral presentation.

The number of slides is at most 10. Length of a team report is 7-8 minutes. The presentation submission deadline is Wednesday, 22 March, and Friday, 24 March, after your classes. As always, the group leader collects the presentations and sends them to me by e-mail in a zip file.

2. Raymond Cattell's Trait Theory of personality.
3. Hans Eysenck's Trait Theory to our understanding of human personality.
4. What personality traits should a good doctor have?
5. Joy P. Guilford's structure of intelligence.
6. Timothy Leary's Interpersonal Circle Model of Personality.
7. Gordon Allport's Trait Theory.
8. Jean Piaget's four stages of Cognitive Development.
